CONCERNING SUBSTANTIAL RELATIONSHIP AND REHABILITATION CRITERIA**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Behavioral Sciences (Board) has proposed modifications made to proposed regulation 16 CCR sections 1812, 1813, 1814, related to Substantial Relationship and Rehabilitation Criteria, and 16 CCR sections 1888, and 1888.1, and the Board's "Uniform Standards Related to Substance Abuse and Disciplinary Guidelines (Revised October 2015)," (which are incorporated into the Board's regulations by reference via section 1888). These regulations were originally noticed on August 16, 2019, the subject of a public hearing on September 30, 2019, and approved as modified by the Board at its March 6, 2020 meeting.
