The meeting was called to order at approximately 10:58 a.m.

1. APPROVAL OF NOVEMBER 18, 2004 MINUTES

VICTOR LAW MOVED, GLYNIS MORROW SECONDED, AND THE COMMITTEE CONCURRED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF NOVEMBER 18, 2004.

2. DISCUSSION OF LICENSED EDUCATIONAL PSYCHOLOGIST LICENSING REQUIREMENTS REVIEW

Mr. Riches discussed that we do not have an LEP member on the Board. Mr. Riches contacted Mark Burdick, LEP, a former Board Member. Mr. Burdick has graciously agreed to become a volunteer for the Board and work with the Board on revisions and updates to the LEP statutes. Mr. Riches plans to meet with Mr. Burdick in March, to bring more information and preliminary proposals to the Board on updates required for the LEP statute. This will be discussed in more detail at the May Board Meeting.

Ms. Ulevitch commented on a discussion at the August Board Meeting regarding Educational Psychologists, and that there were people from professional organizations that were excellent in informing the Board. Ms. Ulevitch recommends getting those people from the professional organizations involved because it would be hard to discipline or look at unlicensed people without a clear idea of the scope of practice. Mr. Riches informed Ms. Ulevitch that he and Mr. Burdick will discuss this when they meet in March.

Ms. Morrow asked if there was a possibility to get an LEP on the Board as there is an open seat, and it would be beneficial in that an LEP can address the LEP issues. Mr. Riches has addressed this with the Department Director and Deputy Director of Board Relations. They are aware of the vacancy and are doing what they can.
