Are You a Recent Graduate? Make Your Hours Count!

Applicants for an associate registration who graduated on or after January 1, 2020* need to be aware that they may only count post-degree hours of experience gained under the "90-day rule" if the workplace required the applicant to complete Live Scan fingerprinting prior to gaining those hours.

What is the "90-day rule"?

The "90-day rule" is a clause in the law that allows applicants for registration as an Associate Marriage and Family Therapist, Associate Professional Clinical Counselor, or Associate Clinical Social Worker (Associate), to count supervised experience gained during the window of time between the degree award date and the issue date of the Associate registration number, <u>IF</u> the Associate application is received within 90 days of the qualifying degree award date.

However, applicants who graduate on or after January 1, 2020 may <u>only</u> count post-degree hours of supervised experience gained under the 90-day rule if the workplace required the applicant to complete Live Scan fingerprinting prior to gaining post-degree experience hours. Post-degree hours may only be counted as of the date recorded at the bottom of the Request for Live Scan Service form.

Why do I need to make sure my employer has me complete Live Scan fingerprinting in order to count supervised experience hours gained under the 90-day rule?

The goal of the 90-day rule is to secure public protection by ensuring that applicants who are applying for an associate registration were fingerprinted by the employer. The reason for this requirement is that these individuals have graduated and are no longer under the close purview of their school, but they are not associates yet and therefore are not yet under the jurisdiction of the Board.

What is required of applicants?

Applicants must obtain a copy of their completed "State of California Request for Live Scan Service" form and provide a copy to the Board when applying for licensure in order to count post-degree experience hours gained under the 90-day rule.

What happens if the applicant's employer does not require fingerprinting, or if the applicant cannot obtain a copy of the completed "Request for Live Scan Service" form?

Post-degree experience hours gained during the window of time between the degree award date and the issue date of the Associate registration number will not count.

How can applicants ensure that they meet this requirement?

Applicants must obtain a copy of their completed "Request for Live Scan Service" form from the employer and keep it in a safe place. The applicant must submit a copy of this form upon application for licensure. Other documentation cannot be accepted as the law does not allow for any alternatives.

What if I have multiple employers, and I wish to count supervised experience hours gained under the 90-day rule from each of them?

Fingerprints are not shareable across agencies, and therefore you would need to fingerprint for each employer and obtain and save the completed "Request for Live Scan Service" form from each employer in order to count hours at that agency.

Does this apply to MFT or PCC Trainees?

The Live Scan requirement does not apply to trainees. However, if there is a possibility that a trainee will be continuing to work for the same agency after graduation, the individual will need to have been fingerprinted by that agency before they can count any <u>post-degree</u> hours under the 90-day rule at that agency. The fingerprinting may be completed while a trainee.

Will I still have to fingerprint for the Board when I apply for my registration number? Yes. Fingerprints are not transferrable across agencies or employers. You will need still need to do Live Scan fingerprints specifically for the Board as part of your associate application.
