Subject: Overview and Discussion of Other States' Telehealth Allowances

The Association of Social Work Boards (ASWB) provided the Board with two spreadsheet which, among other things, tracks the requirements related to telehealth and supervision via videoconferencing for the social work licensing boards in other states.

- Attachment A outlines licensure waivers and allowances that other social work licensing boards adopted due to due to the COVID state of emergency, which often included waivers and allowances for telehealth and supervision via telehealth.
- Attachment B provides information about other social work licensing boards' laws related to clinical supervised experience and electronic practice.
