
If joining using the meeting link

Accept any request for permission to use your microphone and/or camera.




If joining from Webex.com

The meeting information will be displayed. Click "Join Event".




Connect via telephone*:

Microphone

Microphone control (mute/unmute button) is located on the command row.





Green microphone = Unmuted: People in the meeting can hear you.

Red microphone = Muted: No one in the meeting can hear you.




If you cannot hear or be heard


- Click on the bottom facing arrow located on the Mute/Unmute button.
- 2 From the pop-up window, select a different:
 - Microphone option if participants can't hear you.
 - Speaker option if you can't hear participants.

If your microphone volume is too low or too high

- Locate the command row click on the bottom facing arrow located on the Mute/Unmute button.
- From the pop-up window:
 - Click on "Settings...":
 - Drag the "Input Volume" located under microphone settings to adjust your volume.









Audio Connectivity Issues


If you are connected by computer or tablet and you have audio issues or no microphone/speakers, you can link your phone through Webex. Your phone will then become your audio source during the meeting.

- Select the "Call In" option and following the directions.










2 In the text box:

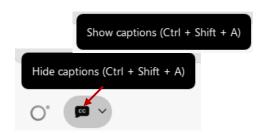
If connected via telephone:

• Press *3 to unmute your microphone.


Webex provides real-time closed captioning displayed in a dialog box on your screen. The captioning box can be moved by clicking on the box and dragging it to another location on your screen.
