*Continuing Education; Exams; Renewals*

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Board of Behavioral Sciences (Board) has made proposed modifications to proposed regulations in the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 16, Division 18, amending sections 1822.51, 1829.2, 1877.2, 1887, 1887.1, 1887.2, 1887.3, 1887.4.2, 1887.4.3, and 1887.12, related to continuing education, exams and renewals. These regulations were originally noticed on December 5, 2025, and approved as modified by the Board at its February 20, 2026 meeting in response to comments and to add delinquent renewal requirements for licensees and registrants.
