- You were admitted to the United States as a refugee pursuant to section 1157 of title 8 of the <u>United States Code</u>; or
- You were granted asylum by the Secretary of Homeland Security or United States Attorney General pursuant to section 1158 of title 8 of the <u>United States Code</u>; or
- You hold a special immigrant visa and were granted a status pursuant to section 1244
  of <u>Public Law 110-181</u>, <u>Public Law 109-163</u>, or section 602(b) of title VI of division F of
  <u>Public Law 111-8</u>, relating to Iraqi and Afghan translators/interpreters, or those who
  worked for or on behalf of the United States government.

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- **→** To qualify for an expedite, attach one of the following types of documentation:
- ✓ Form I-94, Arrival / Departure Record, with an admission class code such as "RE" (Refugee) or "AY" (Asylee) or other information designating you a refugee or asylee.
- ✓ Special immigrant visa that includes the category of "SI" or "SQ."
- ✓ Permanent Resident Card (Form I-551), commonly known as a "Green Card," with a category designation indicating that you were admitted as a refugee or asylee.
- ✓ An order from a court of competent jurisdiction (a court or administrative agency having jurisdiction and legal authority to deal with the subject matter) or other documentary evidence that provides reasonable assurance that you qualify for expedited licensure.
- → Attach this completed form and required documentation to the TOP of your application.
